AI creative and academic writing: every feature and how it compares with the competition

Lexia Studio is a complete writing studio. In one place you write the work, check it against real sources, keep your own style, typeset it for delivery and publish it. This brochure details what it does and compares it, feature by feature, with eleven tools on the market.

Who it is for

Student and PhD candidate

Find real sources in OpenAlex and Crossref, cite in APA or whatever style your faculty asks for, check that every claim holds, apply your university's rules and hand in a PDF with cover, contents and correct pagination.

Novelist

Character and place cards that mention themselves in the text, board and timeline, multi-book series with shared material, a visual canvas and a co-author writing with your style DNA.

Poet

Syllable and rhyme verification, metric analysis, a poetry book generated sequentially in the voice of a saved poet, and version comparison.

Screenwriter and playwright

Standard screenplay format, pages and minutes, cast, Fountain and Final Draft export, a full scene generator and canvas sync.

Features in detail

Writing and editor

The editor is the centre: chapters, focus mode, daily goal, version history, autosave, dictation, read-aloud and project templates that already carry structure.

Sources and citations

Real academic search in OpenAlex and Crossref, open access through Unpaywall, validated DOIs, a PDF library that answers questions from your own papers, an @ shortcut to cite without leaving the text, APA, MLA, Chicago, Vancouver and IEEE styles, and import from Zotero, BibTeX and RIS.

Verification and integrity

Unsupported-claim checker, evidence panel for and against, originality and AI-text detection, an AI footprint declared inside the work, a downloadable integrity report, your university's rules applied, and an authorship proof signed against your style DNA.

Style and author voice

Style DNA measures your voice and applies it to everything the AI writes. Different analysis per genre and subgenre, forensic depth for flash fiction, public-domain author corpora gathered from the web, reusable templates and drift comparison between versions.

Story planning

Character and place cards per project, automatic mentions in the text, board and timeline, multi-book series sharing material, and a visual canvas with connections and generated scene art.

Screen and stage

Standard screenplay format with scene detection, page and minute counts, cast lists, export to Fountain, Final Draft (FDX), CSV and Courier PDF, a full scene generator and automatic scene-to-canvas sync.

Delivery and publishing

Word, typeset PDF with cover, contents, lists of figures and tables and correct pagination, LaTeX, EPUB, pre-press preparation, team comments and publishing with a DOI.

Three things you will not find together anywhere else

One home for creative and academic work

The same novel, screenplay and thesis live in one space, each with the tools it needs and none of the ones it doesn't: the menu changes with the project's genre.

Your voice, measured and applied

Style DNA is not a tone setting, it is a measurement of your writing injected into every suggestion. You can save it, edit it, compare it across versions and reuse it in other projects.

From the first sentence to the DOI

Writing, checking sources, proving authorship, typesetting with cover and contents and publishing with a permanent identifier all happen inside the same product, with no detour through other tools.

Competitive comparison

Forty-five features against eleven academic, creative and screenwriting tools. S = yes · P = partial · N = no · ? = unconfirmed. Our own features were verified in the product; competitor data comes from their public pages.

Dictation and read-aloud · Author corpus gathered from the web · Publishing with a DOI. And something that is not a feature: no tool answers the question of how to prove you wrote a text. Lexia's authorship proof does.

What is still ahead

- A Word and Google Docs add-in: Paperpal and SciSpace have one, and many people hand in Word files.
- Sentence-by-sentence language review with accept and reject, at Paperpal's level.
- Systematic-review screening at Elicit's scale.
- A wider catalogue of citation styles.
- A desktop app and offline work.
